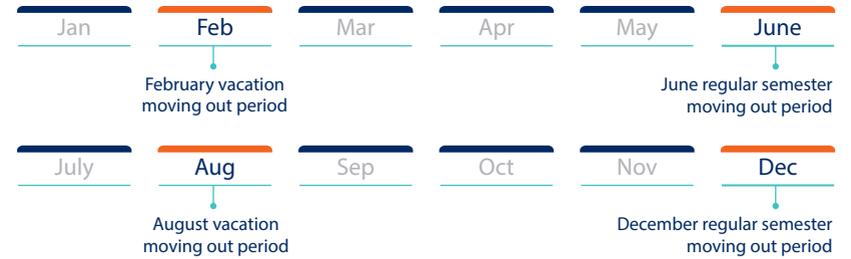
Selection criteria

- 1 Students with high penalty points will not be selected
- 2 Student with the highest score will be selected first
- 3 If all conditions are equal, the time when the application was submitted will be the deciding factor
- 4 (Based on the last modification time when the application information is modified)

Roommate applicants are based on "low penalty points", "high score", and "high priority application time" among applicants. If there is a discrepancy in the applied building between roommates or if the roommates do not pay the dormitory fee, other applicants will be disadvantaged, so please be aware when submitting the application. If the number of applicants exceeds the quota, they may be assigned to the building other than their preferred ones.

| Processing procedure

- ① Accident report: Please fill out the attached "Confirmation of Issuance of Accidents in School" form and submit it to the student team.
 - In the accident report, only the facts – the circumstances of the accident and the details of the injury, should be included in as much detail as possible according to the 5th and 5th principles. See Examples in Forms.
 - Deadline for submission: If possible, within seven days of the accident
- ② Treatment progress: You have to pay for the treatment at your own expense. At this time, please receive a medical certificate and a hospitalization confirmation, and keep the treatment fee and the receipt paid according to the medicine.
- ③ Insurance Claim: After the treatment is completed, the insurance claim will be made through the email of the person in charge (student team, insurance company), and the insurance company will determine whether the insurance payment is made after screening. You will be charged 100,000 won for personal/property compensation.

| Student Researcher Industrial Accident Insurance System

A. Subject to application: University/research among research activities workers under the Act on the Creation of Safety Environment in Laboratories Student researchers participating in research and development projects carried out by institutions, etc.*

* Not only students in the course of their degrees, but also participants in the R&D project confirmed to enter the upper degree program Including graduates, students on leave, and graduates

B. Subject to subscription: Ulsan Institute of Science and Technology (* will sign up at the university headquarters)

C. Criteria for recognition of occupational accidents: Injury, disease, disability, or death that requires at least four days of care related to the performance of R&D tasks, including commuting disasters

D. Criteria for payment of insurance benefits

1) The average wage notified by the Ministry of Employment and Labor, even if the suspension benefit or compensation pension is less than the minimum wage It is paid on a standard basis, and subsidies for returning to work, etc. among vocational rehabilitation benefits are not paid

2) Other insurance benefits, such as disability benefits and survivor benefits, shall be paid on the same basis as wage workers

E. How to claim compensation for industrial accidents: A student researcher directly selects and applies for the following 1) or 2)

1) (Online reporting) At the Corporation's Employment and Industrial Accident Insurance Total Service (<https://total.comwel.or.kr>) Report the relevant complaint by entering the "Civil Complaint Receipt/Report → Application for Medical Care (or Claim for Compensation)" route

2) (Offline reporting) Fax, mail, or visit to the branch office of the Corporation

What to do in the event of a fire

- Notify that the fire has occurrence
 - Shouting "Fire" (or calling the security office for help 6971,6950) to alert the surrounding area of the fire upon discover
 - Press the transmitter 'press' switch on the nearby fire hydrant to alert the surrounding area of the fire
 - Use a nearby fire extinguisher and fire hydrant to extinguish the fire as quickly as possible
 - Report to the fire department (119) if the initial fire extinguishing fails or the fire gets bigger



Fire protection and emergency evacuation plan in dormitory

- Fire extinguisher
 - Powder extinguishers are placed in various parts of the building, such as corridors and public spaces
- Automatic sprinkler will turn on when a fire is detected
- Emergency evacuation maps are attached to the inside of each room door and must be understood
- In the event of a fire, evacuate through the stairs following the green exit sign Never use the elevator (can be stopped in the event of a power failure)
- If it is impossible to evacuate downstairs, evacuate to the rooftop



- If it is difficult to get out of dormitory rooms, evacuate to the next generation through a lightweight partition installed between the households Evacuate to the evacuation space within the household.

※ Do not place objects around evacuation spaces or lightweight partitions



Emergency evacuation tips

- Familiarize yourself with evacuation instructions, remember two or more evacuation routes
- In the event of a fire, do not panic and calmly evacuate to the emergency exit (Follow the guide light and guide sign in a low position)



- When clothes catch fire, cover your eyes and mouth and roll on the floor



- How to Use a descending life line



Take the support out of the window

Hook the stiffener hookon the supporting

Throw the reel out of the window.

Climb down the wall safely.

Securely fasten the braces to the chest.

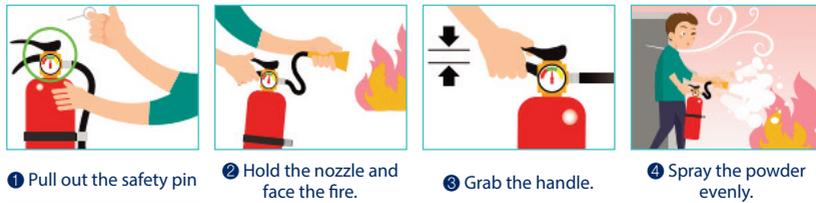
How to use the microwave properly

- Metallic containers and containers with gold or silver wires should never be used because they can cause sparks.
 - Hard-shelled foods (eggs, chestnuts, etc.), bottles with a lid, sealed containers, and sealed instant foods can explode if heated as they are, so open and heated
- Be careful not to let water inside the product. If water overflows during cooking and enters the motor, it causes permanent failure.
 - Example) When the rice is boiling over (X) - Never heat the food for a long time or pack it in newspapers, magazines, etc. to prevent fire. e.g. Wrap sweet potatoes in newspaper and heat them (X)

Daily fire prevention tips

- No smoking in the dormitory building (including toilets, rest rooms, veranda, etc)
- Learn how to use a fire extinguisher on a daily basis and use it in case of emergency
- Do not use combustible or flammable substances in the living room
- The fire door in the emergency stairs should be kept closed
- Prevention of electric fires
 - Switch off and unplug electrical appliances when not in use
 - Do not use heating appliances for heating devices
 - Do not use substandard electric machine furniture, etc (Check "전", "검", and "KS")
 - Avoid using multiple electrical appliance plugs in one outlet

Earthquake prevention guide

- Be familiar with the evacuation site :
 - Under my desk
 - Where you can avoid falling objects
 - Protect your head with cushions, pillows, and safety helmets
- Do not place heavy objects, glass products on high places
 - Keep dangerous items underneath
 - 3rd bookcase and 4th shelf storage, etc
- Store fragile glass products thoroughly
 - Broken glass fragments can be a risk factor in urgent cases.
 - Glasses, glass cups, glass frames, monitors, water bottles, wall clocks, flowerpots, etc
- Prepare personal safety items for evacuation
 - Safety helmet (to be provided by the school safety team)
 - Emergency lighting
 - Other: Evacuation supplies and personal medications
 - Thick indoor slippers
- Be aware of the location of the power circuit breaker and gas valve
 - First, Secondary Dormitory: Gas valve (Veranda), Power valve (Veranda), power circuit breaker (in shoe rack)
 - Tertiary Dormitory : Gas valve (Veranda), Power Breaker (near the wall opposite the shoe rack)
 - Fourth Dormitory : Gas valve (Veranda), Power circuit breaker (wall in room)

※ buildign 309 gas valve is located in the common boiler room outside the room

In the event of an earthquake

※ Dormitory evacuation location: Parking lot outside the dormitory

- In the event of an earthquake, the shaking time is 1-2 minutes at the longest, so during this time, go under the table, avoid the body, and protect your head with a cushion when there is no table.
- Open the door to secure the exit and shut off the gas/electricity etc.
- When a fire breaks out, you should turn it off calmly and quickly.
- In the event of an earthquake, windows and signboards are very dangerous, so you should not rush outside.
- In the event of an earthquake or fire, do not use the elevator, and when you are on board, press all buttons to get off quickly and evacuate. If you're trapped, call for help through the intercom.
- After the big vibration stops, evacuate to a large space such as an open space or a park. Also, things that are not fixed, such as block walls and vending machines, may fall, so you should not get close.

Chapter 1 General Provisions

Article 1 (Purpose) The purpose of these instructions is to define the matters necessary for the operation and management of the Student Residence of UNIST (hereinafter referred to as "Student Residence") that is established to provide a safe and pleasant residential and academic environment in accordance with Article 95 of the School Regulations of Ulsan National Institute of Science and Technology ("UNIST").

Article 2 (Definition) Student Residence in these instructions means the buildings, site and its attached facilities used for residential purposes for UNIST students.

Article 3 (Supervision) The Student Residence shall be supervised by the Dean of Admissions and Student Affairs under the orders of the President, and it shall be managed and overseen by a Director of Student Residence.

Article 4 (Requirements for Admission) Only UNIST students who receive approval from the Director of Student Residence (hereinafter referred to as "Student living in the Student Residence") can be admitted to the Student Residence. A person who are not a student living in the Student Residence (hereinafter referred to as "Special Resident") can, however, occupy the Student Residence during a certain period with permission from the Director of Student Residence as long as the occupancy period fits the educational or research purpose and doesn't disturb the management of the Student Residence.

Article 5 (Activities of Students Living in the Student Residence) ① Students living in the Student Residence shall preserve order and maintain a pleasant environment.

② The activities of the Students living in the Student Residence are allowed within the range of the Director of Student Residence's acknowledgement.

Article 6 (Guidelines on Living) The Director of Student Residence shall establish Guidelines on Living in the Student Residence for the orderly communal living of Students and Special Residents living in the Student Residence after going through a review by the Student Residence Steering Committee and receiving approval from the President.

Chapter 2 Organization

Article 7 (Director of Student Residence, etc.) ① There are a Director of Student Residence and a Student Residence Team in the Student Residence.

② The Director of Student Residence is appointed for 2-year term by the President from among teachers at the assistant professor level or higher and can serve consecutive terms.

③ The Student Residence Team is appointed in accordance with all personnel relations regulations of UNIST.

Article 8 (Roles) ① The Director of Student Residence shall handle everything regarding the guidance of the Students living in the Student Residence and the management and operation

of the Student Residence under the orders of the Dean of Admissions and Student Affairs.

② The Student Residence Team shall guide the Students living in the Student Residence and assist the Director of Student Residence regarding the management and operation of the Student Residence under the orders of the Director of Student Residence.

Chapter 3 Committee

Article 9 (Establishment) Student Residence can have a Student Residence Steering Committee (hereinafter referred to as "Committee") to review important matters regarding the operation of the Student Residence.

Article 10 (Composition) ① The Committee shall consist of seven or fewer members including the chairperson of the Committee.

② The Dean of Admissions and Student Affairs shall be the chairperson of the committee and the Director of Student Residence, leaders of each team of the Student Residence, leader of the facility team and student council president of the Student Residence shall be ex officio members. Other members may be appointed by the President as necessary on the recommendation of the Dean of Admissions and Student Affairs.

③ There is an assistant administrator on the Committee, and the Student Residence Team shall be the assistant administrator.

Article 11 (Functions) The committee shall review the following tasks:

1. Establishment, amendment and abolition of the Instructions on the Operation of the Student Residence and Guidelines on Living in the Student Residence;
2. Admission and expulsion standards of the Student Residence;
3. Matters regarding the standard of boarding expenses and amount to be borne by students living in the Student Residence;
4. Business plan, budget and account settlement of the Student Residence;
5. Reward (reward points and rewards) and punishment of students living in the Student Residence (forced expulsion and admission restriction and/or suspended forced expulsion and admission restriction) (Amended on 01/16/2017); and
6. Other matters that the Dean of Admissions and Student Affairs or the Director of Student Residence acknowledge the necessity for.

Article 12 (Meetings) ① Meetings shall be convened by the chairperson as necessary and commence with the attendance of a majority of the incumbent members, and resolutions shall be passed with the consent of a majority of those present.

② The chairperson shall be the chairperson of the meeting, and he/she will be deputized by a member who he/she designates in the case of his/her absence.

Chapter 4 Admission and Expulsion

Article 13 (Admission Qualifications and Residency Period) ① The residency period of students living in the Student Residence is during their attendance period, as a rule. However, if there is a shortage of residential areas in the Student Residence, the Director of Student Residence can restrict the admission standards by setting separate criteria.

② The residency period of Special Residents can be approved after reviewing the request by their department.

Article 14 (Restrictions on Admission) ① A student who falls into any of the following categories can't live in the Student Residence, except for students who receive special permission from the Committee:

1. A person in the midst of a disciplinary action more severe than suspension from school in accordance with School Regulations;
2. A person restricted regarding the admission qualifications by a decision of the Student Residence steering committee;
3. A person with infectious diseases and a carrier;
4. A person on leave of absence from the school;
5. A person with bad conduct and a poor attitude;
6. A person who doesn't pay the boarding expenses within the set period;
7. A person who doesn't submit all the documents needed for admission;
8. A person whose residency period has expired; and
9. A person who the Director of Student Residence recognizes to be unsuitable for communal living.

② A person who receives the permission of the Director of Student Residence, except for items 1 and 2 of Clause 1, can be admitted.

Article 15 (Selection of Students for Student Residence) ① The Director of Student

Residence shall announce the admission qualifications and procedures each semester in advance, and any person who wishes to enter the Student Residence must apply for admission during the announced admission period.

② The Director of Student Residence shall select the students to live in the Student Residence after reviewing the applicants and notify the people who have been approved.

③ The Student Residence Team shall report the selection results of the preceding clause to the Dean of Admissions and Student Affairs according to the academic calendar.

Article 16 (Admission Registration) ① The person who has been selected must register for admission by submitting the required documents including the results of a medical examination issued by a designated medical institution for the given academic year by the date of moving in. Details on the medical examination results shall be determined by the Director of Student Residence.

② The person who has been selected must submit a written pledge regarding admission by the date of moving in.

Article 17 (Room Allocations and Changes) ① Rooms are allocated by dividing them

between undergraduate students and graduate students at the beginning of each regular semester and summer/winter sessions, as a rule. However, rooms may be re-allocated during admission if an adjustment is required because of the extension and alternation of the facilities, changes in the number of persons to be admitted, changes of operation policy, etc.; in this case, rooms may be re-allocated following a discussion with the resident concerned.

② A resident can't change a room on his/her own discretion. If a resident wishes to change a room for an unavoidable reason, he/she must receive approval from the Student Residence by submitting a prescribed request form regarding a room change.

Article 18 (Operation Period) The operation period of the Student Residence shall be classified into regular semesters and summer/winter sessions, and the Student Residence may be closed in accordance with the management policies.

Article 19 (Expulsion) ① A person whose expulsion is decided for any reason including the contracted period, a reason related to admission restrictions, etc. must move out by going through a prescribed process within 10 days from the date of the expiry of the residence, and the Director of Student Residence shall decide matters regarding the usage and additional cost after the contract period as required.

② Personal items left in the Student Residence on the day of moving out until the working hours of the Student Residence Team have ended will be disposed as the Director of Student Residence's policy. (Amended on 01/16/2017)

③ An unauthorized student living in the Student Residence shall be charged a fee as a Special Resident for the unauthorized residence period or must move out immediately. If the unauthorized student or the person who allowed the unauthorized residence is a currently enrolled student of UNIST, he/she may have admission restrictions according to the decision of the Committee.

④ If a resident who moves out doesn't pay the fee in full, the Student Residence can make requests to the relevant department that the student be restricted from admittance to the Student Residence again, that all certificates not be issued, and that the student not be allowed to graduate or take a leave of absence.

Article 20 (Rules and Punishments of Residents) ① All the residents in the Student Residence must complete sexual abuse prevention education and disaster preparedness training; abide by the Guidelines on Living in the Student Residence; and do his/her utmost to create an academic atmosphere within the Student Residence and keep the facilities and equipment in good condition. If a resident violates any of these, the Student Residence Team can impose penalty points corresponding to the severity.

② Reward/penalty points will be accumulated for a year from first being issued, and details regarding imposing the penalty points, the Guidelines on Living in the Student Residence will be applied.

③ Rewards and punishments, compulsory expulsion and admission restrictions, etc. shall be reviewed and judged by the Committee.

Chapter 5 Facilities and Safety Management

Article 21 (Maintenance and Management of Facilities and Equipment) ① If facilities or equipment are damaged, the residents must take measures such as immediately repairing or reporting it, and keep them in the best condition. ② The overall management of common facilities, household furniture and equipment shall be operated by the university and BTL operating company, but the fees for repair of the damages or malfunctions that occur during use shall be borne by the user.

Article 22 (Safety and Health Control) All the residents must always be very careful so that safety incidents such as fires, explosions or collapses and health issues such as contagious diseases do not occur. If a resident has concerns regarding any of these incidents, he/she must report it immediately using emergency contacts such as the Student Residence Team, etc.

Article 23 (Responsibility to Prevent Loss and Theft) All the residents must do their best to prevent loss and theft, and must take full responsibility for any incidents that happen because of their own carelessness, for example, leaving personal items in a public space.

Chapter 6 Finances

Article 24 (Cost Burden) The students living in the Student Residence shall bear the costs needed for his/her life as a resident in the Student Residence, other than the facility costs for the Student Residence, the cost of facility defect repair, and any costs that get aided, based on the user pays principle.

Article 25 (Boarding Expenses) ① Boarding expenses shall be determined by the deliberations of the Committee.

② Students living in the Student Residence shall pay the boarding expenses for each admission period by the process specified in Article 4 (Requirements for the Admission) before the date of moving into a room, as a rule. However, if there is a justifiable cause, the deadline can be extended with the permission of the Director of Student Residence.

③ When a student leaves the Student Residence in the middle of admission because of reasons such as a leave of absence, the boarding expenses shall be refunded according to [Attached Form 1] Standards for the Collection and Refund of Boarding Expenses.

④ If the Student Residence is used for the common purposes of UNIST, the boarding expenses can be exempted after receiving approval from the Dean of Admissions and Student Affairs.

⑤ The boarding expenses for a Special Resident shall be decided separately.

Article 26 (Use of Boarding Expenses) ① Boarding expenses shall be used for all the expenses needed for the operation of the Student Residence.

② A surplus after the settlement of the Student Residence account (if any) can be used for improvement of the Student Residence environment, scholarships, welfare of the students living in the Student Residence, etc.

Article 27 (Budget and Settlement of Accounts) ① Regarding the business year, the fiscal year of UNIST shall be applied, except for the BTL Student Residence, which will apply the BTL business year.

② The BTL operating company must prepare and report a plan for maintenance, management and operations to the President 60 days before each BTL business year commences.

③ Matters regarding budget execution such as the income and expenses not specified in the BTL agreement and other details related to residence operation can be regulated separately by the President.

Article 28 (Application of Regulations) For all matters not specified in these instructions, the decision of the Committee shall be applied.

Chapter 7 Others

Article 29 (Operations during Vacations) During vacations, the Student Residence can be used according to the BTL Enforcement Agreement as long as there's no influence on the admission of UNIST students. Use of the Student Residence by the university for educational or research purposes shall have priority over other uses.

Article 30 (Welfare for Disabled Students living in the Student Residence) Facilities and all requirements for the convenience of disabled students living in the Student Residence shall be established.

Article 31 (Autonomous Activities of Students Living in the Student Residence) The Director of Student Residence can permit or support the autonomous activities of students living in the Student Residence in order to collect the opinions of the students living in the Student Residence and promote autonomous activities by them.

Article 1 (Enforcement Date) These Instructions shall enter into force on the date the President grants approval.

Article 2 (Interim Measures) Matters handled before the enforcement of these guidelines shall be considered to be handled according to these guidelines.

These Instructions shall enter into force on the date the President grants approval.

Addenda (01/16/2017)

Article 1 (Enforcement Date) These Instructions shall enter into force on the date the President grants approval.

Article 2 (Interim Measures) Matters handled before the enforcement of these guidelines shall be considered to be handled according to these guidelines.

Guidelines on Living in the Student Residence

Chapter 1 General Provisions

Article 1 (Purpose) The purpose of these guidelines is to define the rules for living that residents must abide by in the buildings, sites and attached facilities of the Student Residence (hereinafter referred to as "Student Residence") of Ulsan National Institute of Science and Technology ("UNIST") in accordance with Article 6 of the Instructions on the Operation of the Student Residence.

Article 2 (Scope of Application) As long as there are no special provisory clauses, these Guidelines shall be applied to all residents including students living in the Students Residence, Special Residents, etc. excluding the residents who live in areas for married people. The Dean of Admissions and Student Affairs can adjust the scope of these guidelines as required.

Chapter 2 Management of Residents

Article 3 (Living Standard) Access to the Student Residence by students living in the Students Residence shall be allowed between 0:00 and 24:00, and the Director of Student Residence can adjust the hours in case of emergency.

Article 4 (Duties) ① A resident must obey the detailed rules in order to make an effort for public safety and welfare and to create an academic atmosphere.

② A resident must obey the regulations related to the safety management of the Student Residence and take responsibility for fire prevention and other safety accidents by prohibiting the use of fire indoors, for example.

③ A resident must maintain the residence facilities and manage and preserve rented articles with the duty of care.

④ A resident must do his/her utmost for the prevention of theft in the Student Residence.

⑤ A resident must abide by all the reasonable instructions of the related staff members and must cooperate with inspections, cleaning and tidying up.

⑥ A resident must check the bulletin board from the Student Residence Team and other notifications posted on the website regularly.

Article 5 (Room Changes) Residents can't change the room allocated to them on his/her own discretion. If he/she wishes to change the room for an unavoidable reason, he/she must receive approval from the Director of Student Residence in advance by submitting the prescribed request form regarding a room change.

Article 6 (Use of Public Property) ① All the articles for public use can neither be displaced by one's discretion nor be used exclusively.

② The usage charges for services that require personal payments such as electricity, water, gas, etc. shall be

paid by the current resident.

③ Laundry within the Student Residence shall be done in the designated laundry area.

④ When using the ironing room, kitchen, smoking area, etc. pay closely attention to prevent any fires, and after using, the user must make sure all areas are in safety condition and as well as clean up.

Article 7 (Compensation Responsibility) If a resident has damaged or lost facilities of the Student Residence or rented articles intentionally or negligently, he/she must be responsible for their actions and reimburse for any damages or losses.

Article 8 (Advertisements and Notices) ① All the advertisements and notices within the Student Residence shall be written in English or in both Korean and English as a rule, and must be posted on designated bulletin boards after receiving approval from the pertinent team.

② All student notices can be posted for up to 7 days or for the period approved. After the allowed period, all the notices shall be removed by the person who posted them, as a rule.

Article 9 (Duty to Report) Residents must notify the Control Center without delay in the following cases:

1. A big accident has occurred because of a fire, the collapse of a facility, a gas leak, etc., or there are the worries that an incident can occur;
2. An act of causing a fire (cooking, smoking outside of the smoking area, bringing an electric heater into the residence, etc.) or a person who hinders the public safety and order (drinking alcohol, etc.) is found;
3. It is determined that a resident himself/herself or another resident is in mental or physical crisis and risk;
4. There is a resident that has been out of contact for a long time;
5. A person whose admission has not been permitted has been seen within the Student Residence; and
6. If there is any possibility of an accident corresponding to the above.

Article 10 (Rules) Residents must abide by the Guidelines on Living in the Student Residence. If a resident violates any of the guidelines, he/she will receive penalty points according to [Attached Form 1] Criteria for Imposing Student Residence Penalty Points and must fill out and submit the [Attached Form 2] Written Confirmation of Student Residence Rules Violation. If necessary, he/she may receive the relevant measures decided by the Student Residence Steering Committee (hereinafter referred to as "Committee").

Article 11 (Management) ① Residents shall always keep the residential and public areas clean and make an effort to protect the facilities.

② Residents shall actively participate in scheduled or non-scheduled cleaning to maintain a pleasant living environment.

Article 12 (Inspection) ① Residents shall actively cooperate with various inspections of the Student Residence including role calls, safety inspections, equipment inspections, sanitation inspections, etc. to manage safety and develop a sound residence culture.

② Inspections performed by the Student Residence Team can be divided into regular inspections and spot inspections. Details regarding the inspections shall be decided by the Director of Student Residence.

③ The regular and spot inspections shall be carried out by the Student Residence Team, as a rule.

④ Other checks may be performed by the relevant staff in charge.

Article 13 (Moving-out Procedures) ① When a resident moves out of their room, he/she must submit a moving-out form, return any rented articles, and receive a moving-out inspection.

② Those who don't follow these procedures with sincerity may receive a penalty point, and they may have restrictions on admission to the Student Residence in the future.

③ Personal items left in the Student Residence until the end of normal working hours on the expiration date of the allowed occupation will be disposed according to the

Director of Student Residence's policy. (Amended on 01/16/2017)

Article 14 (Rewards) A resident who has done a good deed as an example for others or who has contributed to improve the living environment may receive reward points or a prize according to the prescribed process.

Article 15 (Disciplinary actions) ① A resident who has violated the Instructions on the Operation of the Student Residence or these guidelines may receive a punishment of expulsion and restriction, or relieved of expulsion and restriction from the Student Residence (public service and 20 penalty points) according to the decision of the Committee. (Amended on 01/16/2017)

② Details of the punishment including the types, periods, methods, and grace period for those measures shall be decided by the Committee. (Amended on 01/16/2017)

③ If the resident has an objection to the results of the decisions in items 1 and 2 above, he/she can make an objection to the Student Residence Team within 10 days from when he/she received the results from the Committee. After receiving the written Statement of Objection [Attached Form 3], the Student Residence Team can convene the Committee and deliberate again after receiving approval from the Dean of Admissions and Student Affairs.

Article 1 (Enforcement Date) These Guidelines shall enter into force on the date the President grants approval.

Article 2 (Interim Measures) Matters handled before the enforcement of these guidelines shall be considered to be handled according to these guidelines.

Addendum (07/14/2016)

These Guidelines shall enter into force on the date the President grants approval.

Addenda (01/16/2017)

Article 1 (Enforcement Date) These Guidelines shall enter into force on the date the President grants approval.

Article 2 (Interim Measures) Matters handled before the enforcement of these guidelines shall be considered to be handled according to these guidelines.

[Attached Form 1] Criteria for Imposing Student Residence Penalty Points

1. Principles for imposing penalty points

A. A resident who has violated any instructions and guidelines in the Student Residence shall be received the prescribed penalty points according to the violations.

B. Penalty points will be accumulated for a year from first being issued; if the accumulated points reach 20 or more, the resident is required to move out of the Student Residence due to the cumulative penalty points, and the details of the expulsion such as moving-out time, etc. shall be decided by the Director of Student Residence. (Amended on 01/16/2017.)

C. A resident who violates the category as the reviewed by the Committee of Standards for Penalty Points

should obey the decision of the Committee.

2. Criteria for imposing Penalty Points

A. Penalty points shall be imposed by the Student Residence Team according to the violations in the Student Residence, as a rule, and the details of the violations and corresponding penalty points are specified in the Standards for Penalty Points.

B. Based on the issue, a resident can receive a claim for damages, face criminal charges, or be committed to the Student Scholarship and Guidance Committee.

C. A resident who is determined to disturb the order of the Student Residence may be decided to be punished by the Dean of Admissions and Student Affairs or the Director of Student Residence regardless of the Standards for Penalty Points. (Amended on 01/16/2017.)

D. If a resident has an objection to the penalty points or the decision of the Committee, he/she can make an objection to the Student Residence Team within 10 days from when he/she received the penalty points or the results from the Committee.

3. Reduction of Penalty Points

A. A resident who has done a good deed as an example for others or who has contributed to improve the living environment may be nominated to the Committee by the Student Residence Team as a reward winner, and the Committee can give reward points or a reward to the resident according to the level of contribution.

B. The reward points can offset penalty points, but does not apply to a material violation corresponding to 10 or more penalty points or more. (Amended on 01/16/2017.)
